1. String beads of the same **shape** onto the lace in a repeating pattern.

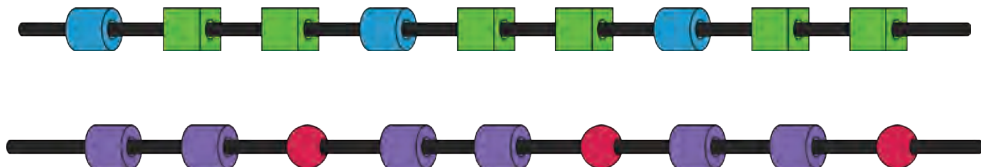


2. String beads of the same **color** onto the lace in a repeating pattern.



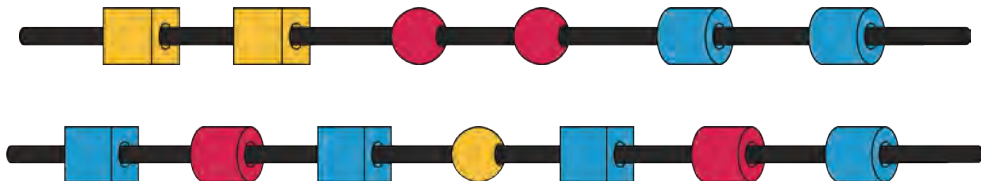

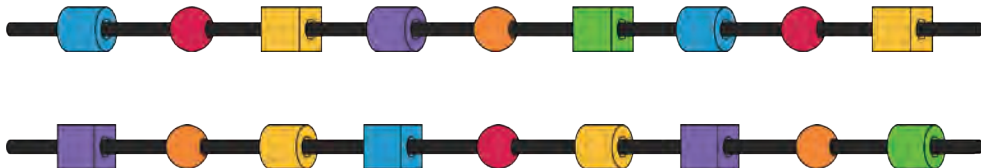
